

VISITORS INFORMATION

We welcome you to Southport Sailing Club and ask you and all our visitors to abide by these rules to ensure that your stay will be pleasurable and at the same time respecting the other sailors and their supporters. We hope that you understand the need for these simple rules and you will accept that they are for the benefit of all who stay.

Arrival times

Our dinghy park will be available from 9.00 am on the Friday immediately prior to the weekend event.

1. Use of Space:

Our dinghy park is of limited proportions and we aim to accommodate our visitors and their equipment as safely and comfortably as we can. Along the lakeside we need you to leave a clear walkway when you place your gazebos, tents, caravans, awnings etc. in the spots you find where you can best support your teams during the event.

Please note we do not permit the pitching of large marquees as they take up valuable space and deny access to the lakeside for too many of our visitors. It is also unacceptable for you to park vehicles etc close to our launching area as this impedes the sailors in the launching and retrieval of their dinghies.

If you are blocking a safety route for emergency vehicles you will be asked to move.

2. Facilities:

There are showers and toilets in our clubhouse. Please remember to leave the facilities as you would wish to find them. Please be careful to take care of our dinghy park and keep it in a clean and orderly condition. A skip is provided for you to deposit your rubbish during your stay and as you leave.

If you have used a chemical toilet please take your waste home. Do not empty your tank in our toilet as it will affect our septic tank.

3. Safety:

Where cooking facilities are being used you must keep a fire extinguishing medium at hand (a bucket of sand or water). No open fires are allowed on the dinghy park.

Petrol/Diesel Generators are not allowed on the dinghy park. Any generators found operating on Southport Sailing Club dinghy park will be shut down. Any person(s) persisting in using a generator will be asked to leave.

Gas Cookers and barbecues must not be left unattended and must not be lit where they could be deemed a fire hazard nor should they cause excessive smoke. Barbecues must be cleared fully after use and be properly disposed of.

Southport Sailing Club shall not be liable for any loss or damage to any vehicle, caravan, contents or any other thing nor for any injury whatsoever to any person whilst on the dinghy park. The Club Committee shall not be liable for any loss or damage to property or personal injury sustained whilst on the premises, howsoever caused.
